

ACTIVITY 1: THE STORIES OF OLD

WHAT YOU NEED

- Play-doh

WHAT YOU DO

- Remind kids that in today's story, Stephen told the Sanhedrin stories from Israel's history.
- Encourage them to use the Play-Doh to shape a character or item from the story.
- As kids work, ask them what they're making and what the story was about.
- Do the same with other Bible stories they have heard in the past weeks.

WHAT YOU SAY

"You are all great Bible storytellers! Stephen kept going and kept living and speaking for God until his last breath. He knew that God knew the end of the story, and he trusted God with everything he had. We can do the same. We can keep going because God knows the end of the story. We might not ever be in a situation like Stephen is, but we face tough times sometimes, too. When we do, we can remember that God knows everything, and we can trust Him!"

ACTIVITY 2: THE END OF THE VERSE

WHAT YOU NEED

- Memory Verse Phrases (attached—printed or written), Bible, paper & pencil

WHAT YOU DO

- Shuffle each set of phrases, and place a set on the ground
- Lead kids to relay to get the phrases and put the verse in order
- While they are putting the verse in order, set a Bible, a half sheet of paper, and a pencil near them
- When they realize they're missing a phrase, challenge them to write it on the blank half sheet of paper. If needed, they can look it up in the Bible.
