HEY FAMILIES!

In today's Bible story, we learnt about trusting and obeying even when we think we are right. How can you apply that in your life this week?

PRAY TOGETHER

“Heavenly Father, thank You for the reminder to trust and obey no matter what others are doing. Help us remember to pray and ask what YOU would have us do this week so we can follow You. Thank You for loving us and for sending Jesus. In His name we pray, amen.”

ACTIVITY 1: EVEN WHEN

WHAT YOU NEED

Bible, Play-Doh®

WHAT YOU DO

- * Encourage kids to sculpt something that represents times they can trust and obey even when others don't.
- * They might sculpt a toy (when they're playing with friends), a stuffed animal (when they're at a sleepover), a TV (when they're playing a video game), or a bus (when they're coming home from school).
- * As kids sculpt, use the conversation below to unpack the verse as it relates to today's Bottom Line.

WHAT YOU SAY

“Second John 6 says: The way we show our love is to obey God’s commands. He commands you to lead a life of love (NirV). When we obey God’s commands, we show God that we love Him AND that we love others. And since God wants us to always show our love, we should trust and obey even when others don’t. We can love God by obeying Him and by loving others. So remember: [Bottom Line] trust and obey even when others don’t.”



ACTIVITY 2: LANDING THE VERSE

WHAT YOU NEED

Bible, paper, markers

WHAT YOU DO

- Look up 2 John 6 and review the verse together.
- Give a piece of paper and a pencil to each child.
- Break down the verse into words/phrases
- Assign a word/phrase and instruct them to write their word/phrase on a sheet of paper and then fold it into a paper airplane.
- Challenge them to fold their planes precisely enough that they can sort of control where it goes.
- Do the same for the rest of the words, and fly the planes around the room
- Once all planes have flown, let the kids grab a plane and open it up to reveal the memory verse, and then work together to put the verse in order.

WHAT YOU SAY

“God commands us to lead a life of love. And one of the best ways to show love to the people we trust is to obey them even when others are making different choices. This week, I want to challenge you to trust and obey even when others don’t.”
