
## TODAY'S HOPE IN THE FAMILY ACTIVITIES

## ACTIVITY: A FRIEND LOVES AT ALL TIMES

### WHAT YOU DO

- Write the words of the verse on pieces of paper, broken down as follows for NIV: A friend/ loves/ at all/ times./ They/ are/ there/ to help/ when/ trouble/ comes./ Proverbs 17:17
- Lay the pages on the floor of your area like the numbers of a clock, starting with the first page as one o'clock.
- Ask the kids to stand in the center of the pages and hold out their arms like one arm of the clock.
- Encourage them to start with one o'clock and point to each word of the verse as they "click" around the clock face. The kids say the words of the verse as they go through the clock. Repeat as desired.

### WHAT YOU SAY

"These pages sort of look like a clock face! Why? Because a friend loves at ALL times. Does a friend love at 8:00 a.m. on Saturday when they just woke up? Does a friend love at 1:00 p.m. when they don't get their way? Yes! Because friends love one another at all times! I'm so thankful for examples of good friends like David and Jonathan. And of course, the best friend of all is JESUS! He loves us when we mess up, when we're happy, when we're frustrated, and even when we say something unkind. Because Jesus loves us at all times, we can love others, too!"
