
### TODAY'S HOPE IN THE FAMILY ACTIVITIES

### ACTIVITY 1: NO MATTER HOW HARD YOU TRY

#### WHAT YOU NEED

“The Trouble with Sin” cards (Activity Page), colored cardstock squares

#### WHAT YOU DO

- Show kids the “sin” card.
- Explain that sin is the bad stuff we do: Disobeying, lying, stealing, being disrespectful or selfish, and saying or doing mean or unkind things. Sin breaks our relationship with God.
- Set the card on the floor and lead kids to line up about six feet away from it.
- Give them three pieces of cardstock and show them how to throw them like a frisbee, trying to get the squares to land and cover the “sin.”
- If time allows, collect the cardstock squares and play again.

#### WHAT YOU SAY

Were you able to completely cover the sin? (Pause.) No! No matter how much you tried, you couldn't cover it up. It's like that in life, too. We all mess up and sin sometimes. And when we mess up, we might feel bad about it and try to cover up what we've done. We might tell lies to hide what we did, or we might try to do good things to make up for it. You can talk to God and tell Him the truth about what you did wrong. He loves you. Being truthful with God keeps you close to him.

### ACTIVITY 2: DON'T GET CAUGHT!

#### WHAT YOU NEED

Bibles

#### WHAT YOU DO

- Read Proverbs 10:9 aloud
- Explain to the kids that you will play a version of “Freeze Tag.”
- Select a family member to be “it” for the first round.
- Say the verse together. When you get to the word “caught,” kids should scatter so they don’t get tagged.
- As soon as someone is tagged, say, “FREEZE,” and kids freeze in place.
- The kid who was tagged will be “it” for the next round.
- Repeat as long as time and interest allow.

#### WHAT YOU SAY

“Our verse reminds us that anyone who lives without blame, who chooses to live with integrity, walks safely. But anyone who takes a crooked path, who chooses to be dishonest with their words or actions, gets caught, just like some of you were ‘caught’ in this game of tag. This week, when you find yourself leaning toward making an unwise choice to be dishonest with your words or actions, remember that feeling of being caught in this game. Choosing integrity always keeps us safe because being truthful with God keeps you close to Him.”
