## ACTIVITY 1: CELEBRATE!

### WHAT YOU NEED

“Celebrate!” Activity Page, paper, pencils, crayons, and/or colored pencils


### WHAT YOU DO

- Guide the kids to create their own holiday where they would celebrate what God has done.
- Lead them to imagine what they would do to celebrate His goodness—like throwing a party or cooking a special meal.
- Give each kid a “Celebrate!” Activity Page and encourage them to draw or write how they would celebrate God.
- When kids finish, invite kids to share about their drawing.

### WHAT YOU SAY

“You have such creative ideas for how we can celebrate what God has done! We celebrate what God has done on special days like Thanksgiving, Christmas, and Easter. We celebrate all that Jesus did for us at specific times when we share communion or the Lord’s Supper. There are so many ways we can celebrate what God has done, but we can do it any time we want to! We can make any day a day to celebrate, and you guys have some great ideas how to do it! So remember to celebrate what God has done.”

## **ACTIVITY 2: MEGA SHOUT-OUT!**

### **WHAT YOU NEED**

**Bibles, colored paper, tape, markers, stickers, (optional) mobile device**

### **WHAT YOU DO**

- **Lay out supplies for kids to make a megaphone: colored paper, tape, and markers**
- **Give kids a Bible. Look up the memory verse, Psalm 136:1, and read it.**
- **Encourage the kids to decorate a piece of paper with markers, using the words of the memory verse.**
- **Instruct kids to make a megaphone by rolling the paper into a cone shape.**
- **Help kids tape the paper to hold their megaphone in place.**
- **Encourage kids to use their megaphone to shout-out their memory verse.**

### **WHAT YOU SAY**

**“What a great way to celebrate what God has done! We can celebrate by giving Him thanks because He is good. Reading the Bible is a way we can celebrate what God has done. The Bible is full of stories of real people, like King David, who have experienced God’s goodness and His love. When you remember what God has done and what He is doing in your life right now, celebrate Him by giving thanks. And if you can’t find the words, just remember our memory verse. Let’s show God our gratitude by shouting out Psalm 136:1 one more time.”**
