**Memory Verse:**

“Give thanks to the Lord for he is good.”

PSALM 107:1, NIV

**Bottom Line:**

God is good.

**HEY FAMILIES,**

Nehemiah had a big job to do, and he did not do it alone! He had lots of help and he was probably very thankful to all the people who helped him. Who are some people who have helped you? Are you thankful for them?

**PRAY TOGETHER!**

“Dear God, You are so good! You give us so many people to help us. We just want to thank You for some of the people who help us. And I want to thank You for (name each child), because they are helpful to others around them. We love You, God. In Jesus’ name. amen.”

# ACTIVITY 1: THANK YOU

**What You Need:** cardstock, scissors, crayons, markers, and stickers

**What You Do:**

Cut blank cardstock in half and fold to make a card

**DURING THE ACTIVITY:** Talk about how God gave us a lot of people in our community who help us. Encourage them to decorate a card for someone who has helped them.

**AFTER THE ACTIVITY:** Talk about how we can thank God for people who help us like the people who helped Nehemiah in our Bible Story today.

**What You Say:**

“Let’s think about people in our community who help us. (Pause.) Do you have a mail person who brings you mail and packages? (Pause.) What about a police officer? Do you have one who helps in your neighborhood by keeping you safe or directing traffic? (Pause.) Who else helps us in our neighborhood? (Pause.) Do you have a neighbor who helps you? (Pause.) God gives us all sorts of people who help us. Let’s make a card to thank a special helper in your neighborhood. You can use markers, crayons, and stickers. (Pause.) Don’t forget to write your name on it! (Pause.) These cards are wonderful and will definitely put a smile on their faces! When we have people who help, we should thank them and thank God for giving these wonderful people to us. God is good and gives us people who help. Who is good? God is good.”

## ACTIVITY 2: PAIRED-UP VERSE

**What You Need:** A soft ball

**What You Do:**

Sit opposite your child on the floor. Have the children pass the ball back and forth by rolling it on the floor as you repeat this month's memory verse together. "Let's roll the ball on the floor, back and forth, to each other and say our memory verse together. Ready? 'Give thanks to the Lord for he is good,' Psalm 107:1." (Repeat as a time and interest allow.)

**What You Say:**

"We can give thanks to the Lord. Why? Because God is good. Say it with me! Who is good? God is good!"
