# ACTIVITY 1: LOVE TRAVELS

**What You Need:** : “Love Travels” and “Kite Travels” Activity Pages; cardstock; map scrapbook paper or actual maps; scissors; 1/8-inch ribbon; glue sticks; and marker

## **What You Do:**

Copy “Love Travels” on cardstock. Copy “Kite Travels” and cut out to use as a template on the map paper. Cut ribbon into 12-inch lengths. Encourage children to glue their kite on their paper then add the ribbon tail. Talk about all the places the kite can go in the world, then talk about how we can go tell everyone, everywhere that Jesus loves them and wants to be their friend forever.

## **What You Say:**



## ACTIVITY 2: LETTER WRITING

**What You Need:** : Paper, crayons, and envelopes; Optional fun mailbox to hold letters

**What You Do:**

Encourage the children to use the crayons to write or draw on a piece of paper. Show them how to fold their papers and place them in an envelope. If time allows, children may write more letters and place them in envelopes.

**What You Say:**

“Have you ever received a letter in mail? Maybe you got a card for your birthday or a special note from your grandma. Writing a letter is one way we can tell someone something. Let’s write some messages on our papers then we can fold them to put inside an envelope! Jesus loves you. Jesus loves me.
