# ACTIVITY 1: POPSICLE STICK GARDEN

**What You Need:** : Paper plates; popsicle sticks; crayons and/or washable markers; mini cupcake liners; glue sticks; and a permanent marker

## What You Do:

Copy “God’s way is perfect” on paper to make a label. Encourage children to color their paper plate to look like the earth and sky. Color the popsicle sticks green if desired and glue to their plate. Glue cupcake liners on for flowers. Add the label to their plate. Review the story together.

## What You Say:

“God filled the garden with plants, flowers, and trees. Some of them grew food that you could eat. There were so many animals. It was perfect! God made it all. But, He wasn’t done. God made people, Adam and Eve, to watch over the animals and the garden. God gave them one rule. He told them to never, ever eat the fruit from one tree . . . but they did. They didn’t do things God’s way, so God sent them out of the garden and everything became harder because they didn’t obey God. Everything would have been better if they had only followed God’s way, because God’s way is perfect. Whose way is perfect? God’s way is perfect.”

## ACTIVITY 2: LEAF PAINTING

**What You Need:** : “Leaf” Activity Page; copy paper; black cardstock; scissors; white crayon; gallon-size zipper bags; washable paint in various colors; and masking tape or packing tape

**What You Do:**

Copy “Leaf” Activity Page on copy paper and cut out, one as a template. Trace and cut out the empty leaf shapes from black cardstock, one per child. Place several squirts of different colored paint into the zipper bags and squeeze all the air out. Tape the bag out to the table and tape the leaf cut out over each bag. Have children move the paint around to fill the leaf shape. Mix colors to make new colors. Repeat as desired.

Introduce the idea of a garden.

**What You Say:**






