HEY FAMILIES,

We know that God wants us to talk to Him anytime, anywhere, about anything, right? (Pause.) Right! So, today I want us to take turns telling God anything we want. Now, tell me anything you want to say to God, and we will pray about it. Remember, it really can be about anything! (Wait for answers) Let's pray!"

PRAY TOGETHER!

"Dear God, I love knowing that we can talk to You anytime, anywhere, about anything. Thank You for always listening to us and caring about what we say. We want to tell You [what the children listed]. And I want to tell You (whatever you want to say). You are the best God, and we love You very much! In Jesus' name, amen."

ACTIVITY 1: ANYTIME, ANYWHERE, ANYTHING

What You Need: : “Game Spinner” Activity Page, cardstock, large paper clip, and a metal brad

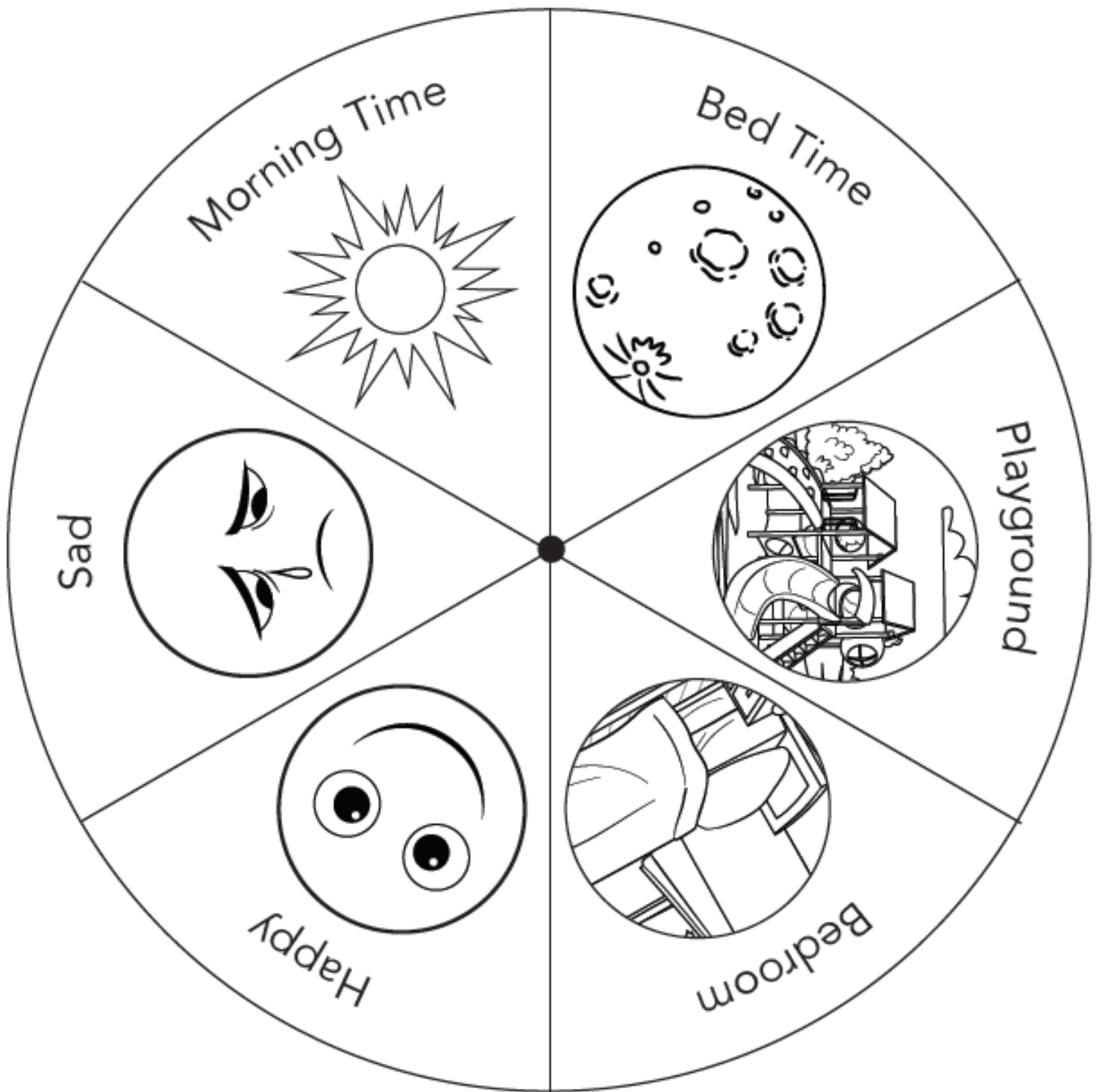
What You Do:

Make one copy of “Game Spinner” on cardstock. Press the metal brad through the designated spot on the game spinner. Hook the end of a large paper clip around the top of the metal brad to make your spinner. Bend the paper clip up a little so that it spins in a circle. The children will take turns spinning the game spinner. It will land on one of the six pictures: Sun, Moon, Playground, Bedroom, Happy, and Sad. Encourage children to say, “I can talk to God . . .” and finish the sentence according to the picture the spinner lands on. Example: If the spinner lands on the sun, the child says, “I can talk to God in the morning.” If the spinner lands on the happy face, the child says, “I can talk to God when I’m happy.”

What You Say:

“God made you, and God made me. He loves us and wants us to talk to Him anytime, anywhere, about anything! **Who made you? God made me!**”

ACTIVITY 2: PICTURE THIS!

What You Need: : “Frame” Activity Page, cardstock, small stickers, and markers

What You Do:

Copy the “Frame” Activity Page on cardstock, one frame per child. Set the stickers and markers in the center of the tables. Give each child a frame to decorate. Read the text at the top and bottom of the frame to the children.

What You Say:

“All month, we’ve been learning that we are important to God! How do we know that? Because God made each one of us! Today, we’re going to decorate this frame. You can take it home and place a picture of yourself in the center of the frame. Here at the top, it says, ‘God made me.’ You are SO important to God, and He loves you very much. At the bottom of the page is ‘Say Cheese!’”

AFTER THE ACTIVITY: “These frames are beautiful, and each one is unique—just like you! One more time, who made you? God made me.”
