Bottom Line:

I can trust God.

HEY FAMILIES,

Our Bible story, today, was about people who had to do a lot of marching around a very big wall. Do you remember how God told Joshua to march his soldiers around the wall of Jericho? What happened? (Pause.) Yes! Joshua did what God said, because he trusted God’s plan, and the wall fell down! Today, we’ll make a list of what you plan to be when you grow up. It’s great to make plans, but we must always remember to trust that God’s plan is best, right? Right!

PRAY TOGETHER!

“Dear God, thank You for letting us dream of what we can grow up and be one day. I think it’s wonderful that [child’s name] wants to be a [occupation they listed]. I pray that as they grow up, they will plan and dream and choose to trust that Your plan is best. We love You, God. In Jesus’ name, amen.”

ACTIVITY 1: RHYTHM STICK PLAYING

What You Need: : “Rhythm Stick Cards” Activity Pages, cardstock, and rhythm sticks or small dowels

What You Do:





Copy “Rhythm Stick Cards” on cardstock and set two rhythm sticks on the floor in a circle where each child will sit. Gather the children to sit with the rhythm sticks on the floor in front of them. Encourage each child to place their hands behind their backs. Sit down in the circle with them with the rhythm cards nearby. Show each card to the children and show the children how to “read” that card with their rhythm sticks. Demonstrate each card. Then, encourage the children to pick up their sticks. Hold up the cards one at a time as they children follow the pattern. Explain that as you lower each card, they are to lower their sticks to the floor in front of them until you hold up the next card. Once you’ve completed all four cards, shuffle and hold them up again, one at a time. Repeat as time and interest allow.

What You Say:

“I have a set of rhythm cards for us to follow. Let me show you each one! (Hold up the Steady Beat card.) This card is our steady beat card. (Demonstrate playing a steady beat.) (Hold up the Floor Tap card.) This card is our floor tap card. (Demonstrate tapping the floor eight times.) (Hold up the Tap Overhead card.) This card is our tap overhead card. (Demonstrate tapping four times overhead.) (Hold up the Lap Tap card.) This card is our lap tap card. (Demonstrate lightly tapping your legs for four counts.)

You followed the plan exactly as shown on the cards!

ACTIVITY 2: WALL BUILDING

What You Need: plastic tablecloth, box of sugar cubes, wipes

What You Do:

Encourage the children to work to build the tallest wall they can out of sugar cubes. Then, once the wall is built, they can knock it down! Repeat if time allows.

What You Say:

“In our Bible story today, what fell down? (Pause.) Yes, a great big wall! Joshua followed the plan that God told him. Let’s stack these cubes to build our own wall as high as we can!”

DURING THE ACTIVITY: “This wall is SO tall! Almost done. Keep building!”

“Wow! Great job! When Joshua followed God’s plan, what happened? (Pause.) Yes, the wall fell down. Are you ready to knock down our wall? Careful! Let’s make sure everything stays on the table.”

AFTER THE ACTIVITY: “That was fun! Joshua trusted God’s plan, and we can, too. Who can trust God? I can trust God!”
