## **TODAY'S HOPE IN THE FAMILY ACTIVITIES**

## **ACTIVITY 1: WHAT'S HAPPENING HERE?**

#### WHAT YOU NEED

"What's Happening Scenarios" Activity Pages, instrumental music, device to play music

#### WHAT YOU DO

- Set the "What's Happening Scenarios" Activity Pages out around your small group area.
- Play instrumental music quietly as the kids look at their pictures.
- Give the kids a few minutes to think about what they think is happening in each picture.
- After a few minutes of discussion, stop the music.
- Gather everyone closer together
- Let each child share their picture and their interpretation of what's happening with the rest of the you
- Collect all the pictures to hold up as the kids repeat the Bottom Line in the dialogue given in the next page.



### **ACTIVITY 1: WHAT'S HAPPENING HERE?**

#### WHAT YOU SAY

"There's a lot going on in these pictures! Maybe you've been a part of a scene like this before. Maybe you've been the kid who was left out. Maybe you spilled something or broke something. Maybe you had to move or had to perform in front of an audience. Whether you've felt alone, scared, hurt, or guilty, I have some REALLY good news for you. Because of Jesus and what He has done, nothing can separate you from God's love! He loves you no matter what you do, no matter how you feel, no matter what!"

(Hold up the picture of the kid spilling the drink.) "When you mess up  $\dots$ "

(Hold up the picture of the kid who's left out.) "When you feel alone . . ."


(Hold up the picture of the kid who's hurt.) "When you're hurt . . ."


(Hold up the picture of the kid with the moving truck.) "When you're sad or unsure . . ."

(Hold up the picture of the kid at the piano.) "When you're nervous or scared . . ."


KIDS: "God loves you no matter what."













## **ACTIVITY 2: PRAY TOGETHER**

#### WHAT YOU NEED

Index cards and pencils

#### WHAT YOU DO

- Give each kid an index card and a pencil.
- Encourage the kids to write down one hard, sad, or awesome thing that happened this week. (Or draw an emoji face depicting how they felt.)
- Gather the cards when the kids finish and shuffle them.
- Pray together, holding each card as you thank God for loving us no matter what.

#### WHAT YOU SAY

I'm so glad to know that when I'm happy or sad, frustrated or scared, when I've messed up or when I've done the right thing, God loves me no matter what. And YOU can know that, too. Even in all of these situations you wrote about, God loves you no matter what. Let's pray together.
