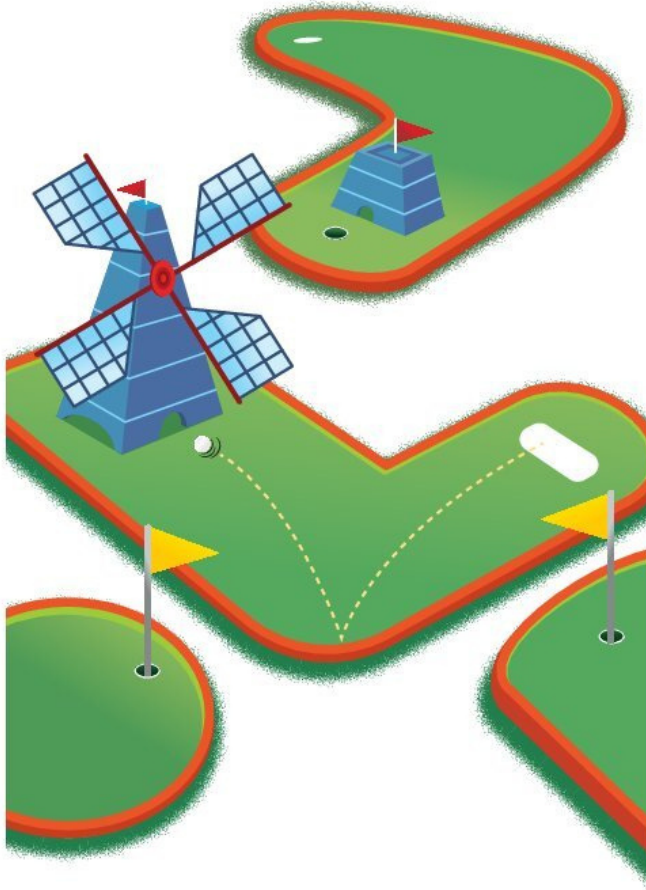

Weekly Cues



Preschool

ENGAGE IN EVERYDAY MOMENTS TOGETHER



Morning Time

When you go into your child's room, say: "Good morning, [child's name]! I'm so glad it was God's plan for me to be your (mommy/daddy). I love you!"



Cuddle Time

Cuddle with your child and pray: "God, when things are hard, help us to keep trusting Your plans, like Joseph did."



Drive Time

While on the go, take turns naming things that are hard to do. End by talking about how we can trust God's plans even when they are hard, like Joseph did when he was in Egypt.



Bath Time

Cut a heart shape out of a large new kitchen sponge and add it to bath time. Talk about how we think of love when we see hearts. And God loves us... A LOT! We can trust God's plans for us because God loves us.
