ENGAGE IN EVERYDAY MOMENTS TOGETHER



Morning Time

When you go into your child's room, say: "Good morning, [child's name]! God knows the plans He has for us because God loves us."



Cuddle Time

Cuddle with your child and pray: "God, every time we see a rainbow in the sky, help us remember that You keep Your promises."



Drive Time

While on the go, say, "Let's look for the rainbow color red." Then look for red things. Do this with all of the colors of the rainbow. Talk about how God made the rainbow to remind us of His promise to never flood the whole world with water again.



Bath Time

Add bathtub crayons to bath time. Practice drawing rainbows and naming the different colors. Talk about how God made the rainbow, and every time we see a rainbow in the sky, God is remembering His promise to never flood the whole world with water again.
