ENGAGE IN EVERYDAY MOMENTS TOGETHER



Morning Time

When you go into your child's room, say: "Good morning, [child's name]! We are going to look for the people who help us today, and thank God for them."



Cuddle Time

Cuddle with your child and pray: "God, thank You for the people who help us, like (name people who help you and your child). You are good!"



Drive Time

While on the go, take turns naming people who help you. Each time you name someone, say, "God is good!"



Bath Time

Add toy people/baby dolls/action figures to bath time. Tell your child the toys need help getting clean. As your child helps clean their toys, talk about how we have people who help us, too. We can thank God for people who help us.
