# **Activity**

### **Story Basket**

### What You Need:

Basket, happy face, sad face, spoon or piece of toy food, pillow, toy car, bandage, and goggles (If you don't have one of these items, look at the list below and find something that can represent the item you're missing.)


#### What You Do:

Put all items in the basket. Say, "Our Bible story today was about how Jesus was always with Peter. Jesus is always with us, too. This basket has things in it that show when Jesus is with us. Reach in and pull one thing out of the basket."

As your child pulls out each item, say, "Jesus is with you when . . . (use the list below to finish the sentence)." Continue with each item until the basket is empty.

Happy face – Jesus is with me when I'm happy.
Sad face – Jesus is with me when I'm sad.
Spoon/toy food – Jesus is with me when I'm eating.
Pillow – Jesus is with me when I'm sleeping.
Car – Jesus is with me when I'm riding in a car.
Bandage – Jesus is with me when I'm hurt.
Goggles – Jesus is with me when I'm swimming.

Say, "Jesus is always with you, and He wants to be your friend forever! Who wants to be your friend forever? Jesus wants to be my friend forever."
